Meet Vikas Kapil, DO, MPH



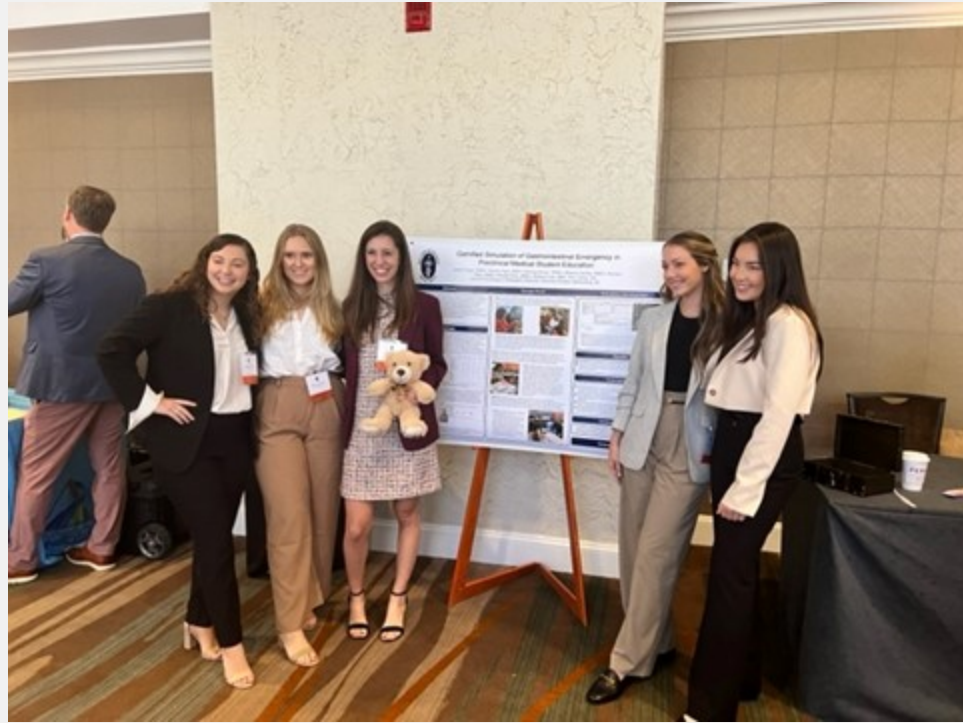

Board certified in Emergency Medicine and Occupational Medicine, Dr. Kapil has performed Emergency Deployment & Response for Anthrax in 2002, the BP Gulf Oil Spill in 2010, Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant in 2011, Elk River Chemical Spill, Charleston, WVA in 2014, West Africa Ebola Response in 2014-2016, and SARS-CoV-2 Pandemic from 2020-Present.

In 2014, he was the recipient of the Arogya Kiran Puraskar Award for the Development of Emergency Medicine and Trauma Care in India.
